Another year has flown by, and it has been a vibrant period at the museum.

This year, we welcomed four new volunteers: Cheri Bush, Cheryl Fleming, Jessie Martin, and CeCe Yeats. Their contributions, along with our existing volunteers, board members, and staff, have been invaluable. Together, we have accumulated a total of 3485 volunteer hours.



During the past few months, I organized a successful book drive, gathering over 75 gently used books for our research library and resale at discounted prices, with the proceeds benefiting the museum.

Additionally, I dedicated six Mondays to conducting private tours for Road Scholar, an American non-profit specializing in educational travel for older adults. They had already booked seven dates for the 2024 season until they had to cancel due to the company closure of American Queen Voyages.

On a more positive note, I've broadened the range of products available in the museum store and refreshed our local history collection with new titles.

As always, I have been tending to the garden, planting flowers and maintaining our campus's aesthetic appeal.

It has been a joy serving our members, and I am excited to bring more to everyone in the upcoming year.

Curator's Highlights of 2023

In the beginning of the year, I created an exhibit in our hallway exhibit case titled, Vine to Wine in Nez Perce County. The exhibit centers on the history from 1864 to the present day vineyards, wineries and the owners who worked hard making wine from the vines they nurtured.

Another new exhibit titled, Lewiston Eerie History, was created by our Museum Support, Kalisa Boyd. This exhibit includes a small 1880s casket with a window. If you are interested in seeing these new exhibits, they are still available to view.

Our booth at the Nez Perce County Fair was a big success. We enjoyed meeting the many people who stopped by and our booth won first place! In keeping with the theme It's a Big Wheel Affair at the Nez Perce County Fair, I created our booth with wagon wheels, a barn background and a monitor showing many local historical images of wagons to cars with large wheels. That is me to the right holding our ribbon and certificate awarding our two complimentary booths for the 2024 fair. We greatly appreciate everyone who helped at our booth and those who supported our society during the fair.

We had a great year with our North Central Idaho Speakers Bureau, aided by a \$14,825,49 grant from the Idaho Governor's Lewis & Clark Trail Committee. 49 presentations were done for area schools, organizations, as well as Island Park, Idaho. 3055 students, 1759 adults and 103 via Zoom attended the presentations.

I want to thank Fred Rauch, Cheri Bush and Cheryl Fleming for assisting me with digitizing, cataloging, archiving and grants. They have been a great help to me and to the museum. Most of these projects are still ongoing by the three wonderful volunteers.




